In the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT WHICH MAY BE WITHHELD BY  
STAMPERS UNDER THE CIGARETTE EXCISE TAX LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The third paragraph of section 30 of chapter 64C of the  
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 3 of chap-  
3 ter 362 of the acts of 1969, is hereby further amended by  
4 striking out the words "one dollar and sixty cents", in line 5,  
5 and inserting in place thereof the words:— two dollars.

By the following a portion of section 2 of chapter 10 of the laws of 1901 is amended, to read as follows: "The words 'one dollar and fifty cents' in section 2 of chapter 10 of the laws of 1901, is hereby further amended by striking out the words 'one dollar and fifty cents' in line 2 and inserting in their stead the words—two dollars."

striking out the words "one dollar and fifty cents" in line 2  
and inserting in their stead the words—two dollars.
