Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commonwealth shall assume all county
2 taxes.

1 SECTION 2. Section 30 and section 31 of chapter 35 are
2 hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on July first, nineteen
2 hundred and seventy-two.
