AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MALDEN TO PAY CERTAIN SCHOOL CUSTODIANS A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY FOR OVERTIME WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The city of Malden is hereby authorized to appropriate
- 2 and pay to certain custodians in the school department of
- 3 said city, the sum of one thousand nine hundred twenty-sev-
- 4 en dollars and fifty-six cents for overtime work performed
- 5 between the period of September first nineteen hundred and
- 6 seventy to and through December thirty-first nineteen hun-
- 7 dred and seventy.

RESOLVED: That due to the failure of the Malden School Committee to seasonably notify the Mayor and City Council of an agreement entered into with certain Malden Public School employees in the year 1970, namely custodians, relative to overtime pay, and therefore no appropriation having been made for this purpose by said Mayor and City Council,

Now, therefore, the Malden City Council hereby petitions the Honorable Legislature of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to enact legislation whereby the City of Malden shall pay to certain custodians of the Malden Public Schools for the period, September 1, 1970 through December 31, 1970, an amount not to exceed a total of one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven dollars and fifty-six cents, (\$1,927.56).
