## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Two.

### AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general  
2 appropriation act, or of any provision of any supplementary  
3 appropriation act, the number of permanent positions duly  
4 approved with reference to the department of public welfare  
5 appropriated for personal services shall be increased to in-  
6 clude every year-round temporary position for which, for a  
7 continuous period of three years or more past compensation  
8 has been duly paid or authorized. The director of personnel  
9 shall, by title and code number and subject to the approval  
10 of the commissioner of administration, certify to the budget  
11 commissioner, the comptroller, the director of civil service, the  
12 appointing authority, and the house and senate committees  
13 on ways and means, each such position to be so included.  
14 The provisions of this act shall not apply to any present or  
15 future temporary position created by any general or special  
16 act the operation of which is expressly limited as to time, nor  
17 for any such position which by its nature or intent is tem-  
18 porary.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July first, nine-  
2 teen hundred and seventy-two.
