AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR JAMES HALLICE, A MEMBER OF THE UNIFORMED BRANCH OF THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE FOR ELIGIBILITY TO TAKE A PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, James
2 Hallice, a member of the uniformed branch of the division of
3 state police, shall be entitled to count as creditable service
4 three years' service as a member of the Cambridge police
5 department for eligibility to take the promotional examina-
6 tion for corporal in said division. Said three years of service
7 shall also be counted toward the salary grade in which said
8 individual is established.
