RESOLVE CONTINUING THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE WATER RESOURCES COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY RESOURCES OF THE PARKER RIVER.

1 *Resolved*, That the water resources commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to continue the investigation and
3 study authorized by chapter thirty of the resolves of nine-
4 teen hundred and seventy-one, relative to the public water
5 supply resources of the Parker River. Said commission shall
6 file an interim report not later than the last Wednesday of
7 January, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, and its final
8 report not later than the last Wednesday of June, nineteen
9 hundred and seventy-three.
