### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL COURT OFFICERS IN CERTAIN DISTRICT COURTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 62 of chapter 218 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out clause (1), as appearing  
3 in chapter 211 of the acts of 1972, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following clause: —

5 (1) Thirteen court officers: —

6 municipal court of the Roxbury district: —

1 SECTION 2. Clause (6) of said section 62 of said chapter  
2 218, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the line reading "Four court officers: —" the following line: —  
4 East Boston district court.,

1 SECTION 3. Clause (7) of said section 62 of said chapter  
2 218, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 line reading "East Boston district court,".

1 SECTION 4. Clause (8) of said section 62 of said chapter  
2 218, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting after  
3 the line reading "district court of Newton," the following  
4 line: —  
5 first district court of eastern Worcester.,
