AN ACT GRANTING TAX EXEMPTION TO RESIDENT OWNERS OF REAL PROPERTY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 59, Section 5 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by adding at the end:

3 Forty-fifth, real property to the extent of the assessed
4 value of the land; provided such real property is used as a
5 private dwelling place for no more than three families and
6 provided such property is occupied by the owner as his
7 domicile, whether such property be owned by him separate-
8 ly or jointly or as a tenant in common.

9 SECTION 2. The amount of tax on the property exempted
10 under Section 1 shall be paid to the city or town where the
11 exempted property is located by the Commonwealth.
