AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE SOUTHEASTERN PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of Chapter 40B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting
3 in place thereof the following paragraph: —

4 The city or town may, after it has been a member of a
5 regional planning and economic development district for a
6 period of not less than ten consecutive calendar years, termi-
7 nate its membership in the district by a two thirds vote of
8 the city council or by vote of a town meeting or town in favor
9 of terminating such membership. Said termination shall be-
10 come effective at the end of the calendar year within which
11 said termination is voted.
