By Mr. Atkins, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 93) of Chester G. Atkins for legislation relative to voter registration of persons moving from one ward or precinct to another in the same city or town. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO VOTER REGISTRATION OF PERSONS MOVING FROM ONE WARD OR PRECINCT TO ANOTHER IN THE SAME CITY OR TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
- 2 ing out section 3, as amended by chapter 549 of the acts of
- 3 1972, and inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 4 *Section 3.* For all elections and primaries each year, a per-
- 5 son who moves from his place of residence after January first
- 6 of that year into another ward or precinct in the same city or
- 7 town, at least thirty days prior to the said primary or elec-
- 8 tion, shall be registered and may vote in such ward and pre-
- 9 cinct.
