AN ACT PROVIDING THAT PERSONS OVER SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE SHALL NOT BE CHARGED TUITION AT STATE COLLEGES, COMMUNITY COLLEGES, OR THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 7E the following section: —
- 3 *Section 7F.* There shall be no charge for tuition to any
- 4 person sixty-five years of age or over, who is enrolled in a
- 5 state college, a regional community college, or the University
- 6 of Massachusetts.
