**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO
TEACHERS HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 180 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding after Section 17G the following section: —

3 *Section 17H.* Deductions on payroll schedules may be made
4 from the salary of any teacher of any amount which such
5 teacher may specify in writing to the city, town, or district
6 school committee by which he is employed for the payment of
7 a contribution to a Health and Welfare Plan.

8 Any such authorization may be withdrawn by the employee
9 by giving sixty days' notice in writing of such withdrawal to
10 said committee. The treasurer of the city, town, or district
11 shall deduct from the salary of such teacher such amount of
12 contribution as may be certified to him on the payroll and
13 transmit the sum so deducted to the treasurer of the Health
14 and Welfare Plan, provided that city, town, or district treas-
15 urer is satisfied by such evidence as he may require that the
16 treasurer of such Health and Welfare Plan Committee has
17 given to said Committee a bond in a form approved by the
18 Commissioner of Corporations and Taxation for the faithful
19 performance of his duties in a sum and with such surety or
20 sureties as are satisfactory to the city, town or district treas-
21 urer.

22 This section shall take effect upon passage.
