**AN ACT TO PROVIDE TUITION FREE COURSES BE MADE AVAILABLE
TO THE HANDICAPPED.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any course of study available in State primary, secondary,
- 2 or schools of higher learning, regional vocational and any
- 3 other special programs, including community colleges and col-
- 4 leges, shall be made available to paraplegics and those persons
- 5 confined to a wheelchair on a tuition free basis.
