RESOLVE FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO FINDING ALTERNATIVE METHODS FOR THE STATE FINANCING OF PUBLIC SCHOOL EDUCATION.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives and three persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study relative to finding alternative methods for the
6 state financing of public school education.

By the Senate, a petition recommended by the Senate, 1901, of
 the State and members of the State of Massachusetts and pro-
 vision for more for the investigation and study by a special commission
 including members of the General Court, relative to making alternative
 methods for the state financing of public school education.
