**AN ACT EXEMPTING THE OWNERS OF PET SHOPS FROM THE  
OPERATION OF THE KENNEL LICENSING LAWS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 141A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 141B.* Sections one hundred and thirty-seven to one
- 4 hundred and forty-one, inclusive, shall not apply to any pet
- 5 shop the owner of which is licensed under the provisions of
- 6 section thirty-nine A of chapter one hundred and twenty-nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of New York, in session assembled, That the following be and they are hereby enacted into law:
