PROPOSAL FOR LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION FOR
THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN.

A majority of all the members elected to the Senate and House of Representatives, in joint session, hereby declares it to be expedient to alter the Constitution by the adoption of the following Article of Amendment, to the end that it may become a part of the Constitution (if similarly agreed to in a joint session of the next General Court and approved by the people at the election next following) :

ARTICLE OF AMENDMENT.

Article Every child, from the moment of conception shall be entitled to the rights of all citizens.
