AN ACT REPEALING THE LAW REQUIRING THE PERAMBULATION OF
TOWN BOUNDARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sections two, three, four, five and six of chapter
2 forty-two of the General Laws are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Section 7 of said chapter 42, as amended by
2 chapter 157 of the acts of 1962, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out, in lines 19 and 20, the words "and in the manner
4 required by section four."
