AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISBURSEMENT OF MONEYS RECEIVED BY CITY AND TOWN OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES FOR SERVICES RENDERED TO PRIVATE PERSONS OR CORPORATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 53 of chapter 44 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 525 of the acts of 1970, is hereby  
3 further amended by adding at the end thereof the following  
4 sentence: — All moneys received by a city or town officer or  
5 employee as compensation for services rendered as such officer  
6 or employee to private persons or corporations, shall be  
7 deposited in the municipal treasury in a separate account and  
8 shall be disbursed to the person entitled to receive the same  
9 without further appropriation.
