

By Mr. Saltonstall, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 844) of James R. Carlin for legislation to direct the Department of Natural Resources to convey certain land of the Commonwealth in the town of Ipswich to the county of Essex. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Three.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO CONVEY CERTAIN LAND OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE TOWN OF IPSWICH TO THE COUNTY OF ESSEX.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for the use
3 for highway purposes by Essex county of certain land of the
4 commonwealth, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emer-
5 gency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
6 public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of natural resources, on behalf
2 of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized and directed to
3 convey to Essex county, to be used for highway purposes, the
4 land of the commonwealth under the control of said depart-
5 ment, located in the town of Ipswich, described in a plan of
6 land entitled, "County of Essex, Massachusetts, Plan of Land
7 Owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts located in Ip-
8 swich, Mass., James R. Carlin, County Engineer, Nov. 3, 1972,
9 Scale 1" = 40' " filed in the office of the County Engineer and
10 to be filed in the Essex South Registry of Deeds, and more
11 particularly described as follows: —

12 Parcel #1. A parcel of land located on the southerly side of
13 Linebrook Road in the town of Ipswich and bounded northerly
14 by Linebrook Road about 1030 feet; and southerly by remain-
15 ing land of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts about 1023
16 ft., said parcel containing about 16,000 square feet.
