Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 chapter 823 of the acts of 1965, is hereby amended by adding
- 3 the following sentences: — Such vehicles may be operated by
- 4 persons over the age of eighteen.
