AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CONTENT OF SAUSAGE OR
SAUSAGE MEAT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as most recently amended
- 3 by chapter 243 of the acts of 1962, is hereby further amended
- 4 by inserting after the word "sheep," in line 3, the word: —
