appointment has been made from eligible lists established for police services positions and a person so appointed has completed the prescribed police training course; provided, that the appointing authority has complied with all instructions issued by said administrator.

SECTION 2. This act shall cease to be operative on December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.

Chap. 109. AN ACT RELATIVE TO BORROWING BY CO-OPERATIVE BANKS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The first paragraph of section 31 of chapter 170 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 54 of the acts of 1979, is hereby further amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: -Such corporation, by vote of at least three-fifths of all its directors, may borrow from any source to meet withdrawals, pay taxes, make loans on shares or accounts of the corporation, or make or acquire real estate loans; provided, that any such borrowing shall be subject to the approval of the commissioner if such borrowing together with the aggregate of all borrowings then outstanding would exceed an amount equal to twenty per cent of the assets of such corporation.

Chap. 110. AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSES TO OPERATE CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The fifth paragraph of section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 361 of the acts of 1973, is hereby amended by adding the following two sentences: -All operators of motor vehicles and trailers which are regarded as registered under a general distinguishing number or mark as provided in section five shall be subject to the rules and regulations establishing classifications for operator's licenses. In absence of a registered gross weight for such vehicle or trailer, the gross vehicle weight rating as established by the original manufacturer of the chassis shall be used to determine the class of license required to operate the aforementioned motor vehicles and trailers.
