AN ACT PROVIDING FOR EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS WHO ARE GRADUATES OF TRADE OR VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 62A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 62B.* The provisions of sections sixty-one and sixty-
- 4 two prohibiting the employment of certain minors shall not
- 5 prohibit the employment of minors who are graduates of trade
- 6 or vocational high schools provided that such minors are em-
- 7 ployed in the same occupation as they were trained for in such
- 8 trade or vocational school.
