RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF CHARLES C. CORNELL.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion of the commonwealth, there shall be allowed and paid out
3 of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to Charles C.
4 Cornell the sum of money received by the commonwealth as a
5 result of the escheating of the estate of Waldo W. Cornell, Bristol
6 County Probate Court 133588, which estate amounted to one
7 thousand three hundred eighty-two dollars and fifty-two cents,
8 and was deposited in the name of the Commonwealth of Massa-
9 chusetts because the special administrator of the estate of the
10 said Waldo W. Cornell was not aware of the existence of one
11 Charles C. Cornell, 1725 Bay Street S.E., St. Petersburg, Florida,
12 son of the late Waldo W. Cornell, being his only and lawful heir.
