AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE TAXATION OF LAND ACQUIRED BY EMINENT DOMAIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3B of chapter 59 of the General Laws,
2 as inserted by chapter 393 of the acts of 1946, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
4 thereof: —

5 *Section 3B.* All interests in real estate situated within the
6 Commonwealth heretofore or hereafter acquired by any corpora-
7 tion by eminent domain and all such interests in real estate
8 heretofore or hereafter purchased by any corporation when it
9 could have been so acquired shall, unless expressly exempt by the
10 charger of such corporation or by statute, be taxed to such
11 corporation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply to taxes levied for the fiscal
2 year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
