

By Mr. MacKenzie of Wareham, petition of Charles A. MacKenzie, Jr., that the Department of Public Health be authorized to sell and convey certain land to the town of Lakeville. State Administration.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO SELL AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND IN THE TOWN OF LAKEVILLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public health, in the name and on behalf of
2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to sell and convey to
3 the owner of record of certain land in the town of Lakeville a
4 parcel of land forty feet in width running through the land of
5 such owner, which parcel was taken by eminent domain on April
6 13, 1926, and is no longer needed for the purpose of supplying
7 water to the Lakeville Hospital, said parcel being bounded and
8 described as follows:

9 Beginning at a point in the property line now or late of the
10 heirs or devisees of Ezra Fillmore, located about 1,050 feet
11 southeasterly from Rhode Island Road, so-called; thence North
12 87° 31' East 309 feet, more or less, to a point in the property line
13 now or late of Abraham L. Stockley; thence South 29° 30' East
14 44.9 feet, more or less, along said property line of Abraham L.
15 Stockley to a point; thence South 87° 31' West, 309 feet, more
16 or less, to a point in the property line now or late of Sarah I. and
17 Grace I. Paun; thence North 29° 30' West 44.9 feet, more or less,
18 along said property line of Sarah I. and Grace I. Paun to point of
19 beginning. Containing 0.28 of an acre, more or less, being a strip
20 40 feet in width and a part of property now or late of the heirs
21 or devisees of Ezra Fillmore. Being same land and rights
22 appurtenant thereto taken by department of public health by
23 order of taking dated April 13, 1926, and recorded in Plymouth
24 county registry of deeds in Book 1504, Page 83.
