RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF JOHN PAUL SULLIVAN.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion there shall be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the
3 Commonwealth to John Paul Sullivan, the sum of four thousand
4 six hundred and sixty-six dollars and sixty cents for services
5 rendered by him as legal counsel in the matter of Americus
6 Cleffi, et al vs. Board of Trustees, Southeastern Massachusetts
7 University, et al during the period from March three, nineteen
8 hundred and seventy-one, through May three nineteen hundred
9 and seventy-one, a claim for which is not enforceable against the
10 commonwealth.
