AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW PERTAINING TO DEPENDENCY ALLOWANCES UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of Chapter 566 of the Acts of 1959, as appearing in

3 amended by inserting after the word "earning", the following
4 words: — "or who are attending an educational institution on a
5 full time basis".
