AN ACT TO EQUALIZE THE ADULT FEE FOR FISHING LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eleven of Chapter 131 of the General Laws as most
2 recently amended by Chapter 652 of the Acts of 1969 is hereby
3 further amended by striking out in the second sentence of the
4 second paragraph the words: – “and to a female over eighteen,
5 four dollars and twenty-five cents.”
