*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

2 by Chapter 802, Acts of 1972, is further amended by adding  
3 after section 19, line 5, the following words: "specialized codes"  
4 to include the following: Rules and Regulations of the Board to  
5 Facilitate the Use of Public Buildings by the Physically Handi-  
6 capped.
