By Mr. Kiernan of Lowell, petition of Franklin N. Flashner (Chief Justice of the District Courts) and Cornelius F. Kiernan that provision be made for payment of expenses to special justices assigned to sit in jury of six sessions. The Judiciary.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF EXPENSES TO SPECIAL JUSTICES ASSIGNED TO SIT IN JURY OF SIX SESSIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 81 of chapter 218 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 17 of chapter 810 of the acts of
3 1963, is hereby further amended by inserting after the first
4 sentence of the first paragraph the following sentence: —

5 A special justice assigned to sit in a jury session in a court
6 other than the court to which he was appointed shall be
7 reimbursed by the commonwealth for the traveling expenses
8 incurred by him incident to said assignment; provided, however,
9 that the court in which said special justice is assigned to sit is
10 more than forty miles from the court to which he was appointed.
