AN ACT RELATIVE TO FUNERAL AND BURIAL EXPENSES FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 63B the following section: —
- 3 *Section 63C.* The commission shall pay the reasonable
- 4 expenses, not exceeding two thousand dollars, of the funeral and
- 5 burial of any police officer who while in the performance of his
- 6 duties is killed or sustains injuries which result in his death.
