AN ACT TO PERMIT ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE TO BE CONSIDERED CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (1) of section 4 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 625 of
3 the acts of 1969, is hereby further amended by adding the
4 following paragraph: —

5 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, accumulated sick
6 leave is to be considered as additional creditable service.
