AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SPECIAL PROVISIONS RELATIVE TO THE BRISTOL COUNTY JUVENILE COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 58 of chapter 218 of the General Laws as amended by
2 chapter 731 of the acts of 1972, is hereby further amended by
3 inserting this special provision of said section 58 of said chapter
4 218 as follows: —
5 “The Bristol County juvenile court shall consist of one justice
6 and one special justice. It shall have a clerk, who shall be
7 appointed by the Governor, with the advise and consent of the
8 Council, and shall hold office during good behavior, but subject,
9 however, to retirement under the provisions of any applicable
10 general or special law relative to retirement systems. It shall have
11 an assistant clerk and a second assistant clerk, both of whom
12 shall be appointed by the clerk, subject to the approval of the
13 justice.”
