AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of the General Laws or special
2 law to the contrary, the director of the bureau of personnel is
3 hereby authorized and directed to change the job groups of the
4 following employees of the Department of Correction:
