AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE BUREAU OF CAREER DEVELOPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1F of chapter 15 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended by chapter 847 of the acts of 1973 is hereby further
3 amended by inserting after the sixth paragraph the following
4 paragraph: —

5 There is hereby established within the Division of Occupa-
6 tional Education the Bureau of Career Development to be
7 directed by the Director of Career Development. Said director
8 shall have the responsibility for the establishment of appropriate
9 programs in junior high and high schools of the commonwealth
10 in career development. The educational programs established
11 pursuant to this paragraph shall be eligible for reimbursement
12 under chapter 74 of the General Laws, for fifty per cent of the
14 net cost of such programs; however nothing in this section shall
14 prohibit the bureau from receiving funds from the federal
15 government for this purpose.
