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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

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AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE RIGHTS OF HOLDERS OF CERTIFICATES OF COMPLIANCE ISSUED TO CERTAIN PERSONS AUTHORIZING THEM TO EXPORT OR SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO DOMESTIC LICENSEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 18B of chapter 138 of the General Laws as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 1022 of the acts of 1971 shall  
3 hereby be further amended by adding the following:

4 It shall be unlawful for any holder of a certificate of  
5 compliance to either directly or indirectly require any licensee  
6 under section 18 to resell any brand item at any stated price. For  
7 any violation of this paragraph, the Commission may suspend or  
8 revoke the holder's certificate of compliance; provided that any  
9 suspension shall be for a period of not less than sixty days.
