### AN ACT FURTHER AMENDING THE SO-CALLED DANGEROUS WEAPONS LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of chapter 269 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by section 5 of chapter 312 of the acts  
3 of 1972, is hereby further amended by inserting in the first  
4 sentence of the first paragraph after the words "sawed-off  
5 shotgun," the words: — "or a zoobow or any similar club  
6 consisting of two sticks connected at one end with rope;"

1 SECTION 2. Section 12 of chapter 269 of the General Laws,  
2 as most recently amended by section 30 of chapter 688 of the  
3 acts of 1957, is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
4 word "blackjack," the words: — "zoobow or any similar club  
5 consisting of two sticks connected at one end with rope,".
