AN ACT GRANTING BENEFITS TO CERTAIN CHILDREN OF CERTAIN RETIREES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Amend section 101, chapter 32, General Laws, most recently
- 2 amended by chapter 793, acts of 1972, to include the words: —
- 3 In the event of the death of a widower receiving a pension under
- 4 the provisions of section 7, chapter 32, General Laws, and is
- 5 unable to provide a pension under the provisions of section 9,
- 6 chapter 32, General Laws, there shall be paid to any surviving
- 7 children under age 18 the sum of \$1,680 per annum or to their
- 8 21st birthday, if they should become full-time students. The sum
- 9 would be paid equal shares administered by a guardian.
