AN ACT PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN INCOME TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR CERTAIN PRIVATE AND PAROCHIAL SCHOOL TUITION PAYMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (a) of section 5B of chapter 62 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in section 5 of chapter 555 of the acts of
3 1971, is hereby amended by adding after paragraph (7) the
4 following paragraph: —

5 (8) An exemption equal to one-half of all tuition paid for
6 each dependent for full time attendance at any accredited
7 private or parochial school, grades one through twelve, within
8 or without the commonwealth.
