## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the  
2 following cities and towns are hereby added to the Massachusetts  
3 Bay Transportation Authority and shall be included within the  
4 provisions of chapter one hundred and sixty-one A of the  
5 General Laws: — Acton, Andover, Attleboro, Avon, Ayer,  
6 Bellingham, Billerica, Blackstone, Boxborough, Boxford, Brock-  
7 ton, Carlisle, Chelmsford, Dracut, Easton, Essex, Foxborough,  
8 Franklin, Georgetown, Gloucester, Groton, Groveland, Harvard,  
9 Haverhill, Holliston, Hopkinton, Hudson, Ipswich, Lawrence,  
10 Littleton, Lowell, Mansfield, Marlborough, Medway, Methuen,  
11 Millville, Newbury, Newburyport, North Andover, North Attle-  
12 boro, Plainville, Rockport, Rowley, Shirley, Southborough,  
13 Stoughton, Stow, Tewksbury, West Newbury, Westford and  
14 Wrentham.
