AN ACT REQUIRING MANUFACTURERS TO MAINTAIN SUFFICIENT SUPPLIES OF PARTS FOR REPAIR PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 43 the following section: —

3 *Section 43A.* No person, firm, association or corporation
4 doing business in the commonwealth shall maintain insufficient
5 stock, supplies or parts preventing their products from being
6 repaired in a period of time not to exceed six days. After the
7 expiration of six days if the product is not repaired due to a
8 lack of parts or supplies, the consumer shall be entitled to rent
9 a substitute product free of charge until the repairs are com-
0 pleted.
