AN ACT TO PROTECT BARGAINING RIGHTS FOR AGRICULTURAL AND TOBACCO WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 150A of the General Laws
2 is amended by adding the following new sentence to the end of
3 the first paragraph: — “This chapter shall also apply to agricul-
4 tural and tobacco establishments and to migrant farm workers.”

1 SECTION 2. Subsection (3) of section 2 of chapter 150A of
2 the General Laws as most recently amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 882 of the acts of 1970 is further amended by striking
4 the words: — “as an agricultural laborer, except as provided in
5 section five A or” in lines 10 and 11 of said section 1.

1 SECTION 3. Section 5A of chapter 150A of the General
2 Laws, as inserted by section 2 of chapter 882 of the acts of 1970
3 is hereby repealed.
