RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY, RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONDUCT OF SUCH DIVISION AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of representa-  
3 tives, the director of employment security or his designee, and  
4 four persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
5 established for the purpose of making an investigation and study  
6 by a special commission relative to the operation of the division  
7 of employment security, rules and regulations governing the  
8 conduct of such division and such other matters relative thereto,  
9 which the commission deems reasonable and appurtenant.
