### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF SPECIAL COMPENSATION FOR CERTAIN TEACHERS OF SPECIAL CLASSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 766 of the acts of 1972 is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 21A as appearing in chapter 318 of the  
3 acts of 1973 the following section: —

4 *Section 21B.* Any teacher of a special class who is receiving  
5 compensation in excess of the regular compensation paid to the  
6 teachers of a city or town pursuant to section 28A of chapter 69  
7 of the General Laws or section 46E of chapter 71 of the General  
8 Laws, as of the effective date of this act, shall continue to receive  
9 such compensation in accordance with the provisions of said  
10 sections, notwithstanding the provisions of sections 8 and 10 of  
11 this act.
