In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

AN ACT PROHIBITING TAX BENEFITS TO CERTAIN CORPORATIONS DOING BUSINESS IN MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No corporation doing business in the state of Massachusetts
2 shall receive any tax benefit or profit from any other special
3 measures that are provided generally as corporate incentives to
4 businesses by the state of Massachusetts if that corporation has
5 subsidiary, other investments or marketing outlets in the Repub-
6 lic of South Africa or the Portuguese Colonies of Angola,
7 Mozambique and Guinea-Bissau.
