AN ACT REQUIRING CABLE ANTENNA TELEVISION OPERATORS TO MAKE CABLE ANTENNA TELEVISION SYSTEMS AND FACILITIES AVAILABLE TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS, COLLEGES, AND UNIVERSITIES AT NO CHARGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 166A of the General Laws, is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after section 5 the following section: —  
3 *Section 5A.* Every licensee shall make available at least one  
4 channel for the exclusive use of the public elementary and  
5 secondary schools and another channel for the public colleges  
6 and universities in the area to be served. Upon receipt of an  
7 application for a license or license renewal the issuing authority  
8 shall give written notice thereof to each school committee and  
9 the chief administrative officer of each public college or  
10 university in the area to be served, which notice shall state the  
11 date and time of the public hearing to be held under the  
12 provisions of section six. No public school, college, or university  
13 shall be entitled to the benefits conferred by this section unless  
14 there is filed with the issuing authority, prior to or at said public  
15 hearing, a letter from each such school, college or university  
16 indicating its intent to use the C A T V System to be made  
17 available under this action.
