**AN ACT AUTHORIZING SPECIALLY TRAINED TECHNICAL AIDES TO ADMINISTER CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 94C of the General Laws  
2 as amended by chapter 1190 of the acts of 1973 is further  
3 amended by inserting after the definition of "State," as so  
4 appearing, the following definition: —

5 Specially Trained Technical Aide — a person who by his  
6 training, skill and experience is qualified to administer or  
7 dispense a controlled substance in the course of his professional  
8 practice when authorized by physician (or dentist.)

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 is further amended by inserting  
2 after clause (c) in the definition of "Administer" the following:  
3 "(d) a Specially Trained Technical Aide."
