**AN ACT PERMITTING RECIPIENTS OF OLD AGE ASSISTANCE AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE TO BENEFIT FROM INCREASES IN FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY PAYMENTS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The department of public welfare, in determining need for aid  
2 or assistance under chapters 118, 118A, and 118D of the General  
3 Laws, and the commission for the blind, in determining need for  
4 aid or assistance under chapters 129 through 150 inclusive of  
5 chapter 6 of the General Laws, shall disregard any amount paid  
6 to an individual under Title II of the social security act, or under  
7 the railroad retirement act of 1937, by reason of the first proviso  
8 in section (e) thereof, in any month after December, 1969, to the  
9 extent that such payment is attributable to the increase in  
10 monthly benefits under the old age, survivors, and disability  
11 insurance system for any such month resulting from enactments  
12 of social security amendments subsequent to December, 1969.
