**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Four.

**AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSISTING YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAMS AT FACILITIES UNDER THE CARE AND CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary all  
2 recreation facilities under the care and control of the metro-  
3 politan district commission who have presently entered into or  
4 subsequent to the effective date of this act, enter into, agreement  
5 for the purpose of providing any service, including, but not  
6 limited to, refreshment stands, skate sharpening, restaurant or  
7 vending facilities, lessons of any nature or parking shall be  
8 awarded to bona fide organizations representing youth sports  
9 programs using such facilities who shall have the responsibility to  
10 manage such facility and following the payment of the reason-  
11 able expenses to operate such facility, the excess shall be  
12 distributed to the organizations mentioned above for the purpose  
13 of allowing children who ordinarily could not participate in such  
14 programs due to the cost of the necessary equipment.
